Six graduate programs in the Pitt School of Medicine sponsor SURP - an annual Summer Undergraduate Research Program.

10 week May - July

[Pitt School of Medicine Summer Premedical Academic Enrichment Program \(SPAEP\)](#)

7 week residential program for college sophomores (>60 credits; science GPA >3.6). Program participants will spend seven weeks strengthening academic skills and enhancing their knowledge in science, scientific writing and public speaking through enrollment in two non-credit courses, MedBio and Med English. They will also learn more about careers in medicine. The program targets applicants who are traditionally underrepresented in medicine.
